## Passive participles

Я жила в доме, который строит Джек.  
I lives in the house that Jack was building.

## Deverbal averbs

7. Пока Джек строит свой дом, он счастлив.

While Jack is bulding his house, he's happy.

While Jack was bulding his house, he was happy.

9. Когда Джек построил свой дом, он женился.

When Jack finished building his house, he got married.
